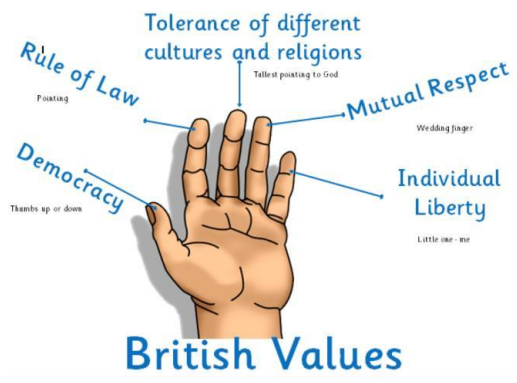


### House Captains 2019

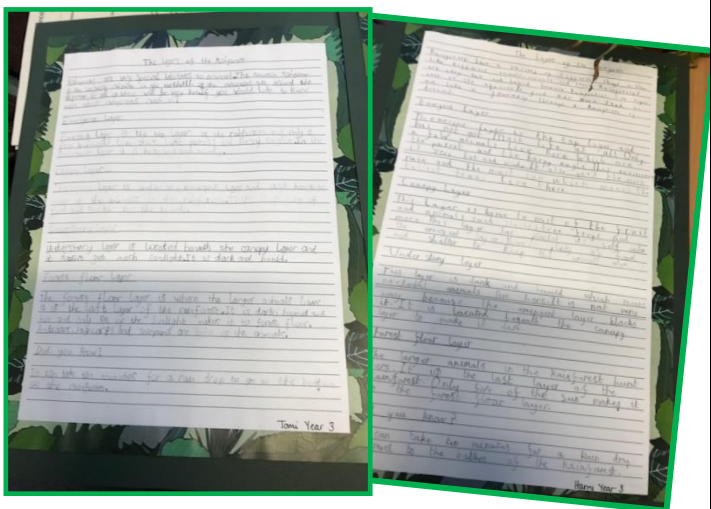
- BLUE – Captain: Sam and Vice: Hollie
