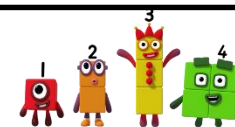

In Mathematics, we use the Numberblocks characters to teach early number skills! The snappy animations combined with engaging story lines introduce concepts of number to support early mathematical understanding. We use 'Tales Toolkit' - a very simple but powerful storytelling idea! Children have the starting tool to independently tell magical stories using the symbols and story words '**Character**', '**Setting**', '**Problem**' and '**Solution**'. We have lots of fun every day using our story telling bags to tell stories together as well as creating our own stories in our 'Talking Tales' story telling area.
