We hope you have a lovely weekend,






Alford Primary School

Hello Yellow Day






Year 5

We are awaiting our first delivery of bagels (hopefully the first week back after halfterm) and then we will start distributing them to children who need them as they arrive at school. Yummy!








More Great Learning
