Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Your child will be learning;

- to identify and control their own feelings and emotions.
- to think about the views of others and manage their own needs.
- to work and play cooperatively with their friends, taking turns and strengthening relationships.
- how to set and work towards simple goals
- how to relax and feel calm during mindfulness activities.

Communication and Language

Your child will be learning;

- to use new vocabulary in small group, whole class and one to one discussions.
- to offer explanations as to why things might happen.
- to express their ideas and feelings using full sentences, as well as beginning to make use of words that join sentences together.
- to further develop their use of questions to find out more about a topic.

Physical Development

Your child will be learning;

- to hold a pencil using a tripod grip and other small tools effectively and to use them with control.
- to develop the foundations of a handwriting style that is fast and accurate.
- to confidently and safely use a range of large and small apparatus alone and in a group.
- to join different movements together confidently.

Literacy

Your child will be learning;

- to continue to explore different letter groups and identify the sounds (phonemes) they make.
- to write short captions and sentences using their knowledge of sounds.
- to develop a love of reading through our RED TED (Read Every Day, Talk Every Day) Reading Reward Scheme.
- to use their sound knowledge to read simple captions and sentences
- to form both lower and upper case letters correctly.

Mathematics

Your child will be learning;

- how to count aloud beyond 20.
- how to count sets of objects beyond 10.
- how to recognise and order the numerals beyond 10.
- how to add two numbers together within 10.
- how to subtract two numbers within 10.
- all about spatial reasoning and how to create and read simple maps.

Understanding of the World

Your child will be learning;

- to continue to develop a school partnership with our friends at Grinling Gibbons Primary School in London.
- to explore non-fiction texts.
- how to use a programmable toy to move in different directions.
- to explore the natural world around them.
- about methods of transport in the past and transport now.

Expressive Arts and Design

Your child will be learning;

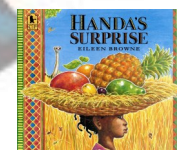
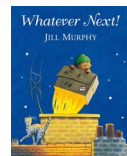
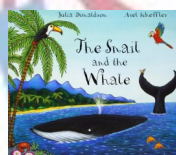
- to listen attentively, move to and talk about music, expressing their feelings and responses.
