## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

### Your child will be learning;

- to identify and moderate their own feelings and emotions.
- to think about the views of others as well as their own needs.
- to work and play cooperatively with their friends, taking turns and strengthening relationships.
- how to work towards simple goals to achieve a challenge.
- how to respond to and approach new experiences.

## Communication and Language

### Your child will be learning;

- to further develop their understanding of new words.
- to re-tell familiar stories once they have developed a deep familiarity of the text – using some exact repetition and some in their own words.
- to express their ideas and feelings using full sentences, making use of words that join sentences together.
- to continue to develop their use of questions to find out more about an interest.

## Physical Development

### Your child will be learning;

- to hold a pencil using a tripod grip and other small tools effectively and to use them with control.
- to develop the foundations of a handwriting style that is fast and accurate.
- to confidently and safely use a range of large and small apparatus alone and in a group.
- to combine different movements together with fluency.

## Literacy

### Your child will be learning;

- to consolidate different letter groups and identify the sounds (phonemes) they make.
- to write short sentences using a capital letter and a full stop.
- to continue to develop a love of reading through our RED TED (Read Every Day, Talk Every Day) Reading Reward Scheme.
- to use their sound knowledge to read simple sentences. With increasing fluency.
- to form both lower and upper case letters correctly.

## Mathematics

### Your child will be learning;

- how to build numbers beyond 10.
- how to explore counting patterns beyond 10.
- how to recognise and order the numerals beyond 10.
- how to explore doubles within 10.
- how to share groups of objects within 10.
- how to explore odd and even numbers within 10.
- how to name and describe 2D and 3D shapes.
- how to use a range of positional language.

## Understanding of the World

### Your child will be learning;

- to continue to develop a school partnership with our friends at Grinling Gibbons Primary School in London.
- to explore recycling and how to take care of our world.
- how to use programmable toys to move in different directions.
- to explore changes in living things.
- to compare and contrast characters from stories past and present.

### Your child will be learning;

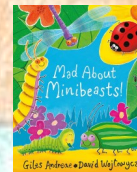
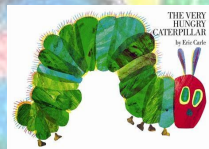
- to create collaboratively sharing ideas, resources and skills.
