Forces & Magnets

- Compare how things move on different surfaces
- Observe how magnets attract or repel each other and attract some materials and not others
- Describe magnets as having two poles and predict whether two magnets will attract or repel each other, depending on which poles are facing.

Light

- Recognise that they need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light
- Recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by an opaque object
- Find patterns in the way that the size of shadows change.

The children will continue to develop their skills through working scientifically.
