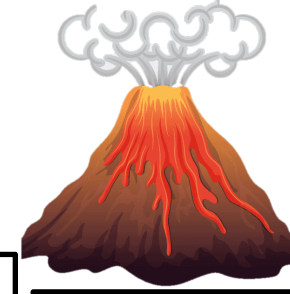




Year 6: Summer Term
