Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Your child will be learning;

- * How to see themselves as a valuable individual.
- * To build constructive and respectful relationships.
- * To understand changes to their bodies as they exercise.
- * To develop their independence with personal needs, e.g. (un)dressing and personal hygiene.
- * To understand and follow our 'Good to be Green' positive behaviours.

Communication and Language

Your child will be learning;

- * How to listen carefully and why listening is important.
- * To join in with repeated refrains and anticipate key events and phrases in stories and rhymes.
- * To use purposeful talk with a partner.
- * To develop their use of story language in oral Helicopter storytelling sessions.
- * To learn new vocabulary through the use of Concept Cat.

Physical Development

Your child will be learning;

- * To use their core muscle strength to achieve a good posture when sitting at a table or sitting on the floor.
- * How to hold a pencil comfortably and with control to draw and write.
- * How use a knife and fork appropriately.
- * Different ways of moving and balancing including hopping, skipping and climbing.

Literacy

Your child will be learning;

- * To engage in oral Helicopter storytelling sessions.
- * To continue to develop their phonological awareness through focused Little Wandle Phonics sessions .
- * To develop a love of reading.
- * To engage in weekly guided reading sessions focussing on Decoding, Prosody and Comprehension.
- * To use their knowledge of sounds to read and write simple CVC words.

Mathematics

Your child will be learning;

- * To represent numbers to five.
- * To find the number that is one more and one less.
- * To recognise and describe simple 2D shapes.
- * To use positional language.
- * To measure short periods of time in simple ways.

Understanding of the World

Your child will be learning;

- * To explore non-fiction texts.
- * About Guy Fawkes and the celebration of Bonfire Night.
- * About the festival of Christmas and how it is celebrated around the world.

Expressive Arts and Design

Your child will be learning;

- * To explore the sounds of different musical instruments.
- * To learn new rhymes, poems and songs linked to different festivals.
- * To rehearse and perform the EYFS Christmas Nativity.
