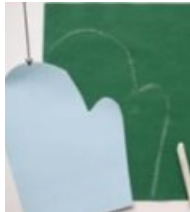


## What I remember from EYFS...

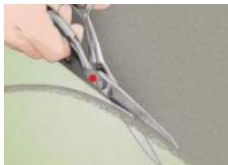
- Exploring simple joining techniques, e.g. Pritt Stick and tape.

2. Cut out your fabric shape using scissors.



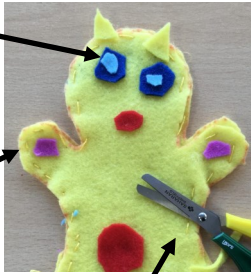
3. Hold your fabric template in place with **pins**.

## Health and Safety...

**Remember to hold scissors safely:**

- Blades closed;
- Hand around blades;
- Always walk when carrying scissors.

## Key Vocabulary...

**Sew** - To join pieces of fabric with stitches.

**Template** - A stencil which you use to help you draw a shape.

**Pins** - Used to hold fabric together before sewing.

**Needle** - A sharp pointed tool used in sewing.

**Thread** - A fine chord of twisted fibres used in sewing.

**Running Stitch** - A simple stitch made up of a small line of stitches.

**Fabric** - Material or cloth.

4. Use a **running stitch** to sew your **fabric** together with a **needle**.



5. Add some features to your toy using glue or Velcro.



## Remember...

A knot needs to be tied at the end of your **thread** before you start to **sew**!



Try using a stapler to join materials together.
