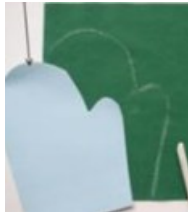


What I remember from EYFS...

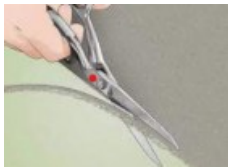
- Exploring simple joining techniques, e.g. Pritt Stick and tape.
- How to weave different materials in and out of a frame.

Key Skills...

1. Make a paper **template** and draw around it with chalk.



2. An adult will help you to cut out your fabric shape using scissors.

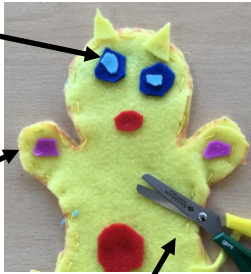


3. Hold your fabric template in place with **pins**.



Design...

Have some features.



Be secure

Be a soft texture

4. Use a **running stitch** to sew your **fabric** together with a **needle**.



5. Add some features to your toy using glue or Velcro.



Remember...

A knot needs to be tied at the end of your **thread** before you start to **sew**!

Health and Safety...

Remember to hold scissors safely:

- Blades closed;
- Hand around blades;
- Always walk when carrying scissors.

Key Vocabulary...

Sew - To join pieces of fabric with stitches.

Template - A stencil which you use to help you draw a shape.

Pins - Used to hold fabric together before sewing.

Needle - A sharp pointed tool used in sewing.

Thread - A fine chord of twisted fibres used in sewing.

Running Stitch - A simple stitch made up of a small line of stitches.

Fabric - Material or cloth.

Try using a stapler to join materials together.
